## 93.7 OUTLAW Online Sweepstakes: Eric Church

93.7 The Outlaw will be running an online contest that will start Monday, September 29<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 am and run through Sunday, October 5<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 PM where listeners will have the chance to win a pair of tickets to see Eric Church: Free the Machine Tour with special guest Ella Langley at the CHI Health Center in Omaha on February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

To enter, listeners must go to 937theoutlaw.com and enter under the corresponding contest title page. Listeners must fill out the contest form and submit before 11:59 pm on Sunday, October 5<sup>th</sup> to be eligible to win. Five winners will be drawn at random from the collected entries and contacted the following week of the contest.

Listeners may only enter once, and multiple entries by an individual, including entries made by using someone else's personal information, will disqualify them. The use of any software or hardware that gives its user an advantage by automating their entries into any contest is prohibited and will disqualify said user. Only one winner is permitted per household.
